PROSPECTUS FOR ADMISSION TO THE FOUR YEAR UNDER GRADUATE PROGRAMMES [FYUGP] IN THE COLLEGES AFFILIATED TO THE UNIVERSITY OF KERALA AND CENTERS OF THE UNIVERSITY FOR THE ACADEMIC YEAR 2026-27.

1. INTRODUCTION

Prospectus for the admission to the **Four Year Under Graduate Programmes [FYUGP]** in Government/Aided/Self Financing Colleges Affiliated to the University and the Centers of the University (UIT's) for the academic year 2026-27, as approved by the University of Kerala, is published herewith. It contains general information and rules relating to the admission to the FYUGP in Govt./Aided/Self Financing Affiliated Colleges Affiliated to the University & Centers of the University (UIT's).

The prospectus issued by the University during the previous years for admission is not valid for the year 2026-27.

Admissions to the seats to be filled by the University to the FYUGP are regulated on the basis of marks obtained in the qualifying examination. The details of seats to which admissions are made, through the rank list prepared accordingly are contained in the relevant paragraphs.

Statute 19 (3) of Chapter 24 of the KUFS 1977 which states that “**no student shall be admitted to any course of instruction in the Colleges in anticipation of Affiliation**”, shall be strictly adhered to, in all the Colleges and Centers.

Statute 31 of Chapter 24 of the KUFS 1977 which states that “**Admission of students to every College shall be subject to the conditions prescribed by the University and the strength of each class or subjects shall not exceed the maximum for the class or subject sanctioned by the Syndicate**” shall be strictly adhered to, in all the Colleges and Centers.

Authority to prescribe qualification for admission to the various courses of studies.

According to Sub-Section (v) and (vi) of Section 25 of the Kerala University Act, 1974, the Academic Council shall have the power to prescribe qualifications for admission of students to the various courses of study (and to the Examinations) and the conditions under which exemptions shall be granted, and to make provision for the admission of students to the various courses of studies on the basis of merit in order to maintain the standards of education.

Agreement for Direct Payment- Relevant provisions for admission to the various courses in Aided colleges.

Article 18 of the Agreement for Direct Payment entered into between the Government and the Educational Agencies of Private Colleges stipulates that all future admission of students to the Private affiliated colleges shall be on the following basis, viz.,

a) Twenty percent of the total number of seats in each college under the Educational Agency shall be reserved for students belonging to the Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes. Those seats which cannot be filled on this basis shall be filled on the basis of merit from among backward minority communities, in case the college is run by a backward minority community and from among OBCs, in all other cases.

b) *Ten/**Twenty percent of the seats shall be reserved for the candidates belonging to the community to which the college belongs. These seats will be filled strictly on the basis of merit from among the students of the said community.

c) *Fifty/**Forty percent of the seats will be filled by open selection on the basis of merit.

d) The remaining seats will be filled by the Educational Agency by candidates of their choice, observing the prescribed eligibility condition.

Note: *This will apply to Forward Community Colleges

**This will apply to Backward Community Colleges

2. GENERAL INFORMATION

➤ **Details and Design of the Four Year Under Graduate Programmes [FYUGP]:**

The FYUGP has a student centric approach in which the student can choose their own pathway for learning. On successful attainment of 133 credits in a three-year period, a student shall be awarded an Under Graduate Degree. In a four-year period, the student can successfully attain 177 credits and shall be awarded with either Undergraduate Honours Degree or Undergraduate Honours with Research Degree. The students can acquire credits through the following categories of courses (subjects).

1. Discipline Specific Core (DSC) Courses.
2. Discipline Specific Elective (DSE) Courses.
3. General Foundation Courses.
 - 1) Multi-Disciplinary Courses. (MDC)
 - 2) Ability Enhancement Courses. (AEC)
 - 3) Value Added Courses. (VAC)
 - 4) Skill Enhancement Courses. (SEC)

Discipline Specific Core (DSC) courses are the core credit courses in a particular discipline. Students may choose DSC courses as their major or minor course of study.

Discipline Specific Elective (DSE) Courses are a pool of credit courses in a particular discipline. These courses offer specialisation to students in a particular discipline. It can be a major or minor course of study.

Multi-Disciplinary Courses (MDC) are Generic Elective courses meant to ensure multi-disciplinary/interdisciplinary education to students. Every Discipline has to offer MDCs.

Ability Enhancement Courses (AEC) are courses offered by language and Literature Disciplines to ensure enhancement of language proficiency among students.

Value Added Courses (VAC) are meant to inculcate ethics, constitutional values, soft skills, sports and such similar values to students. Every discipline may offer VACS.

Skill Enhancement Courses (SEC) are skill based courses in all disciplines which may inculcate skill, competencies and hands on training.

➤ **Credit:**

'Credit' means the value assigned to a course which indicates the level of instruction; One-hour lecture per week equals 1 Credit, 2 hours practical class per week equals 1 Credit.

Students who secure at least 75% of marks in all the six semesters can choose Undergraduate Honours with Research stream in the fourth year.

➤ **General Foundation Courses:**

It is mandatory for all the students who enroll for a four-year UG programme to acquire 39 credits from 13 general foundation courses which are classified into four different sub categories. Each general foundation course has 3 credits. The general foundation courses should be completed in the first three years of FYUGP.

In the first three semesters of the FYUGP, the student shall study one Multi-Disciplinary Course (MDC) each from a discipline other than the Major disciplines already chosen. The first and second MDC (MDC1 and MDC2), respectively in the first and second semesters, can be offered by all departments. The third MDC (MDC3) in the third semester is common to all the students, with Kerala-specific content (KS). Each MDC has 3 credits. Total 9 credits shall be earned from MDC.

The four Ability Enhancement Courses (AEC) are to be offered by English and Other language departments. Out of the total 4 Courses, the student has to choose two from English department and another two from any of the other languages department.

VAC and SEC shall be offered by all Disciplines.

➤ **Exit Points and Credit Requirements**

On Completion of 3 Years (6 Semesters) the student has an option to exit the programme with 133 credits and shall be awarded with a bachelors degree. The Maximum credit a student can acquire in three year period is limited to 150. On Completion of 4 years of study (8 Semesters) by acquiring 177 (maximum of 200) credits the student shall be awarded with a Bachelors (Honours) Degree or Bachelors (Honours with Research) Degree.

➤ **Three different types of Degrees being awarded to the candidates**

- a. Bachelors Degree if the candidates exit after completing 3 years (6 semesters)
- b. Bachelor of Arts (Honours) for those who have scored less than 75% of marks in the first 6 semesters and completed 4 years Degree program.
Eg:- BA(Honours) English
- c. Bachelors (Honours with Research) for those who have scored 75% or more in the first 6 semesters and completed 4 year Degree program.
Eg:- BA (Honours with Research) English.

Attraction/Specialities of FYUG Programmes

- Fast Track Degree achievement in 5th Semester (2 ½ years) by pursuing Online courses in all the first five semesters for a maximum of 7 credits in each semester and once the same is approved by the respective Board of Studies.
- The switching of Major / College/University is permissible during the 3rd semester. For inter disciplinary Double Major programme, student can opt two majors and one minor which will be treated as single discipline. No change in nomenclature of the programme as in the previous year.

APAAR ID is mandatory for a candidate to get college level admission.

**For more details read the Regulation uploaded in the University website*

Any candidate who desires to obtain admission under the University of Kerala for the FYUGP should compulsorily register online before the closure of registration, irrespective of the Category (General/ SEBC/ EWS/ SC/ ST/ Community Quota/ Management Quota/ Candidates from Union Territory of Lakshadweep/ Jammu and Kashmir/ Tamil Linguistic Minority/ Inmates of Government Children's Home / Differently Abled Persons / widows /wards of Defence Personnel, killed or disabled in action or during peace time/ Sports etc.) to which he/she belongs.

No Online Registration shall be permitted after the date of closure.

The allotment of the candidates to the various Programmes will be on the basis of merit strictly following the rules and regulations regarding reservation. The marks secured at Plus Two/ Higher Secondary level is the basic criteria for admission to the FYUGP.

The University will not be conducting online centralized allotment for the following First Degree Programmes/Courses, and those candidates who wish to apply for the same need to apply directly to the Colleges concerned.

- a) All programmes for which Entrance test and Aptitude tests are conducted for admission, like BFA, BPED
- b) Admission to all courses in NISH (National Institute of Speech & Hearing, Thiruvananthapuram) / Bishop Moore College of Hearing Impaired, Manakala, Adoor

BA Music programme: The candidates applying for BA Music programmes must also register online before the closure of registration. There is no centralized allotment for the courses. After registration, the printout of the application form shall be submitted directly to the colleges concerned. The selection of students will be on the basis of Aptitude test conducted at college level. The schedule for conduct of admission to the courses will be published later.

Candidates seeking admission on passing SAY examination during the current academic year will be permitted to register online once the results are published. They will be considered in subsequent allotments.

AGE LIMIT: There is NO upper age limit for taking admission to the FYUGP Programmes in the Colleges affiliated to the University.

INSTITUTIONS, PROGRAMMES AND SEATS

Institutions and Programmes offered: The list of colleges to which admissions are to be made, the programmes offered in each college and the sanctioned strength for each programme, are given as **Annexure I**, in the Prospectus.

Categorization of Seats: Seats available in Govt./Aided/Self financing Colleges/UIT’s are mainly classified as Merit Seats, Community Quota Seats, Management Quota Seats and Reservation Seats.

(a) Merit Seats: The seats in Government/Aided/Self financing Colleges/UIT’s that are filled purely on merit basis irrespective of the Category/ Community, to which the candidates belong, are classified as “Merit Seats.”

(b) Community Quota Seats: The seats in Aided Colleges that are filled by the Colleges concerned, from among the candidates who belong to the community of the Management that runs the College, on the basis of allotment by the University, are classified as “Community Quota Seats”.

(c) Management Quota Seats: The seats in Aided and Self-financing Colleges that are filled by the Managements concerned are classified as “Management Quota Seats”.

(d) Reservation Seats: The seats in Government/ Aided/ Self-financing Colleges/UIT’s, which are earmarked for SC/ST/SEBC/ Economically Weaker Sections (EWS) in General Category/ Differently Abled / Tamil Linguistic Minority (TLM)/ Sports persons/ Transgender candidates etc. are classified as “Reservation Seats”.

3. RESERVATION OF SEAT

Types of Reservation: Seats will be reserved for the following categories in Govt./ Aided/ Self financing Colleges and UIT’s for various First Degree Programmes.

A candidate can claim only one benefit at a time as per his/her choice for a particular purpose.

3.1 Reservation for Nominees

(i) Reservation for Candidates from Union Territory of Lakshadweep.

An additional seat shall be created for each FYUG Programme (wherever necessary) in any Govt. /Aided college, exclusively for the purpose of accommodating students sponsored by the Union Territory of Lakshadweep. This seat shall not be filled up by other candidates. The Head of the Institutions should forward the list of such candidates admitted, separately, to the University immediately after the admissions. (Govt. letter No.5455/B3/2006/H.Edn. dated 15-3-2006) (U.O.No.Ac.B/1/1134/2006 dated 26-4-2006). The students should register online before obtaining admission.

(ii) Concession for Wards of Kashmiri Migrants.

The following relevant concessions are applicable for wards of Kashmiri Migrants for admission to the UG courses in all Affiliated Arts & Science Colleges – U.O.No.Ac.B1/910/Adms/2012, dated 09/04/2012.

- * Extension in date of admission by about 30 days.
- * Relaxation in cut off percentage up to 10% subject to minimum eligibility requirement.
- * Increase in intake capacity upto 5% course wise.
- * Waiving of domicile requirements.
- * Facilitation of migration in second and subsequent years.

(iii) Reservation for candidates from Jammu and Kashmir.

Two seats shall be created over and above the sanctioned strength to accommodate candidates belonging to Jammu & Kashmir for admission to FYUG programmes (wherever necessary) in all the affiliated colleges. (UO No. Ac B1/2292/Adms/2012 dated 01.03.2013). Such students should also register online.

(iv) Reservation for Inmates of Government Children’s Home.

One seat shall be created over and above the sanctioned strength in each Govt./ Aided Colleges for Inmates of Government Children’s Home and Establishments which functions as per Juvenile Justice Act. In the event of non applicants from the above establishments, the applications of candidates from approved Children’s Homes duly recommended by the District Social Welfare Officer shall be considered. (U.O.No. Ac B1/055682/2012 dated 30.04.2013)

(v) Reservation of seats for the widows /wards of Defence Personnel, killed/disabled in action or during peace time.

Additional seats over and above the sanctioned strength may be created as and when required for the widows /wards of Defence Personnel, killed or disabled in action or during peace time, in Central/State Universities /Autonomous/ Professional / Non-Professional Institutions under the purview of Ministry of Human Resource Development as per UGC policy. (Applicable to Army/Navy/Airforce only. Not applicable to paramilitary forces/CAPF/GREF/Coast Guard etc.)

(vi) Reservation for Tamil Linguistic Minority (TLM).

5% seats of the sanctioned strength shall be created, over and above, for candidates belonging to Tamil Linguistic Minority in the following colleges as per GO (Ms) No. 148/96/H.Edn. dtd 01.08.1996. The candidates have to produce a certificate to this effect either from the Village officer/Tahsildar or from the MP/MLA of the area where he/she permanently resides.

- University College, Thiruvananthapuram
- Govt. Arts College, Thiruvananthapuram
- K.N.M Govt. Arts & Science College, Kanjiramkulam
- Govt. College, Kariavattom
- Govt. College for Women, Thiruvananthapuram

Such candidates should opt Tamil as Second Language, if offered by the college.

3.2 Reservation for Differently Abled Persons.

- (i) 5% seats of the sanctioned strength shall be created over and above in Government/ Aided Colleges and UIT’s, exclusively for candidates with benchmark disability (as per clause 32(1) of chapter VI, The Rights of Persons with Disabilities Act, 2016).
- (ii) In all other affiliated Colleges, additional seats will be created over and above sanctioned strength for candidates with benchmark disability as and when required.
- (iii) The persons with benchmark disabilities shall be given an upper age relaxation of five years for admission in institutions of higher education. (as per clause 32(2) of chapter VI, The Rights of Persons with Disabilities Act, 2016)**

As per Clause 2 (r), Chapter I of the Rights of Persons with Disabilities Act, 2016, “Person with benchmark disability” means a person with not less than 40% of a specified disability where specified disability has not been defined in measurable terms and includes a person with disability where specified disability has been defined in measurable terms, as certified by the certifying authority. Candidates who have a minimum of 40% disability alone will be eligible to apply for this quota. **Candidates seeking admission under Differently Abled category should submit the “Certificate of disability”, issued not earlier than 5 years (for**

temporary disability) prior to the submission of application, by the District Medical Board or bodies of higher status, certifying the degree of percentage of disability. The Permanent Disability Card issued by the State Government is also considered. Based on the details furnished in the online application, candidates will be provisionally included under the “Differently Abled” category.

In case of Specific Learning Disability (SLD), even though the percentage of disability is not mentioned in the disability certificate, it should be treated as benchmark disability according to the RPWD Act 2016.

Authorities of all Educational Institutions/Colleges affiliated to the University of Kerala are directed to make appropriate arrangements for medical examination of students with disabilities at the place of counseling/admission, in case, the authenticity of disability certificate being produced by the candidate is doubted. Otherwise, the disability certificate issued by the appropriate authority should suffice. (Circular No. Ac.BI/PH/2011, dated 26.02.2011).

The selection of candidates under this category will be based on the rank in the inter-se- merit list and not on the basis of the Degree of disability.

Note: Candidates or persons with less than 50% physical disability (orthopaedically) can apply for B.Sc. Geology course. The candidates with blindness and colour blindness are not eligible to apply for the course.

'Visually impaired candidates (Low Vision and blindness) equal to or more than 40% disability is not eligible for Science Subject.

' However, Visually impaired candidates irrespective of the percentage of disability are eligible for admission to Four Year Degree Programme in Physics

3.3 Reservation for Transgender candidates:

Two seats shall be created over and above the sanctioned strength in all courses in affiliated Arts & Science Colleges exclusively for admitting Transgender students. (G.O.(Ms)No.153/2018 HEdn dated 03.07.2018). Such candidates should submit transgender identity card issued by the State Government at the time of admission.

There will not be any upper age limit for Transgender candidates for admission to any of the programmes in the affiliated Arts and Science Colleges (G.O. (Ms.) No. 295/2021/HEDN dated 07/07/2021).

3.4 Sports Quota:

Three seats over and above the sanctioned strength shall be created in each Arts and Commerce subjects and one seat over and above the sanctioned strength, shall be created in each Science subjects for Sports candidates in First Degree Programmes. Admission to such seats shall be made by the Principal, from the Sports Quota ranklist approved by the University.

If the required numbers of sportspersons are not available, the seats should be kept vacant and shall not be filled by other candidates.

Norms for Admission to the Seats Reserved under Sports Quota for UG Courses.

The following criteria will be considered for verification and ranking of sports achievement certificate as per the priority given below.

General Guidelines for admission under Sports Quota in Affiliated Colleges and UIT”s

- i) The registration for Sports Quota admission shall be effected in online mode only.
- ii) The Candidates who seek admission under sports quota should apply online within the prescribed time.
- iii) The certificates of achievement shall be scanned and uploaded in the website.
- iv) ***The achievement certificate received before the closure of registration of FYUG Programmes will only be considered for ranking in sports quota admissions.***
- v) For securing admission to FYUG programmes under Sports Quota, including re-admission, **the performance of the candidate during the preceding two years/ Higher Secondary Level shall only be considered.**
- vi) For filling up the seats reserved under Sports quota, hierarchy of preference shall be given as per the norms/guidelines formulated by the University in addition to satisfying his /her academic eligibility.
- vii) When the candidates fulfil minimum academic eligibility, the academic merit shall not be preferred over sports merit in sports quota reservation seats except in the case of a tie in the sports merit.
- viii) The candidates who wish to apply under sports quota should opt “Sports – Yes” during online registration. They need to select the level of achievement and upload corresponding certificate in the respective field in the website. There will be no limit in uploading the number of certificates.
- ix) University will then conduct centralized verification of the uploaded certificates. Provisional Rank list will be published in the website after the verification.
- x) The admission will be effected by the Principal based on this ranked list. Verification of original certificates will be done by the Head of the Department of Physical Education of the colleges concerned. Date of admission will be intimated through press release.
- xi) The original certificate/s from the competent authority/ authorities (Secretary, Organiser etc. as per the Circular Letter No. Ad.D1.3.1276 /74 dated 23.01.1979) must be produced by the candidate to prove his/her claim.

If any discrepancy is noted during the verification of original certificates, the candidate shall not be considered for admission under sports quota.

In case of a tie in sports merit, the following criteria will be considered to break the tie as per the priority given below.

1. A weightage of marks may be given to the candidates who have achievements in following games selected by the University for the purpose of tie breaking only (Major games).
Football, Cricket, Basketball, Volleyball, Shuttle Badminton, Kabaddi, Athletics and Aquatics, Hockey and Handball
2. Preference shall be given to that candidate who represents the discipline (game /sport) of the choice of the college concerned (**Annexure I.A**).
3. Year of achievement (Preference shall be given to achievements in year closer to the year of application)
4. Academic merit.

No Sports Quota applications will be entertained after the last date of registration. Only those candidates, who upload the supporting sports achievement certificates within the prescribed time, will be considered.

Mode of admission under Community Quota in Aided Colleges

1. The seats under community quota in Aided Colleges will be filled by the Colleges as per the allotment memo issued by the University and on the basis of marks/community/caste/non creamy layer certificate issued by the Revenue Authorities/Parish Priest/any other Competent Authority.
2. The Community Quota registration will be in online mode. Candidates need not submit separate application directly in colleges for community quota admission. The candidates can apply for Community Quota along with the General Merit Registration once it is opened. They can submit separate options for Community Quota using the “**Community Quota**” link provided in their profile. It may be noted that only those colleges, based on the community of the candidates, will be displayed for submitting options.
3. The candidates can give a maximum of 20 options. The preference numbers along with the options shows the priority and the allotment is based on this priority. The candidates who do not submit separate options for Community Quota will not be considered for Community Quota admission.
(* serial number of the options is the preference i.e. Sl. No. 1 is the highest priority & Sl. No. 20 is the least priority.)
5. Candidates can add or delete options till the time prescribed for registration.
6. From the applications submitted, the University will issue allotment memo to the eligible candidates on merit basis.
7. The allotted candidates will be notified through press release, to appear at the allotted college by taking the printout of allotment memo for certificate verification and admission thereafter, if eligible.
8. All admissions to Community Quota (including the vacant seats of SC/ST converted in case of Aided Backward colleges with Minority status) are to be filled by Community Quota allotment.

List of communities that are considered for Community Quota admission in various Aided Colleges are given in Annexure VI

Applicants claiming admission under Community quota in Aided Colleges shall belong to the community of the Management which runs the college. They will have to produce community/caste/non creamy layer certificate from the Revenue authority/Parish Priest/any other competent authority concerned, at the time of admission, to prove their claim.

(c) Self-Financing Colleges

In Self financing colleges, 50 % of the total seats shall be filled by the Management from among candidates of their choice adhering to the eligibility conditions prescribed by the University. The remaining seats (50%) shall be distributed and filled as detailed below.

Note: The fee structure of the Self-financing Colleges is higher than that of Govt./Aided Colleges and UIT’s (Ref. Annexure VIII and IX). Fee concession given by the Government is not applicable to candidates enjoying communal reservation, if admitted in Self- financing Colleges.

Mode of admission under Management Quota in Aided and Self Financing Colleges

1. The candidates seeking admission to the Management quota seats in Aided and Self- financing colleges should register online.
2. There is no centralized allotment for seats ear marked under Management Quota. Candidates should contact the colleges he/she intends to take admission and submit the printout of the online registration application form to the colleges concerned.
3. After closure of registration for the centralized allotment process, registration exclusively for Management quota seats will be open. The candidates seeking admission under Management Quota alone can apply till the closure of admission.
4. It may be noted that the candidates who have submitted their online application through the Management Quota link will not be considered for the allotment process. But they will be considered for centralized spot

admission, if any, conducted by the University.

5. If a candidate has already registered for centralized allotment process, it is sufficient for admission under Management Quota also. There is no need of separate registration under Management Quota.

General Rules for conversion of vacant seats

Govt./Self Financing Colleges and UIT”s:

If sufficient candidates are not available for filling the seats reserved for SC/ST candidates, the same will be notified in the media three times (on three different dates) and a separate allotment for SC/ST candidates will be made by the University. However, even after this, if SC/ST seats are still vacant, such seats in Government Colleges/UIT”s will be filled by candidates belonging to Other Eligible Communities (OEC) included in the Annexure IV of the Prospectus and in their absence, will be filled as per Government norms.

If sufficient candidates are not available for filling the seats reserved for SEBC, the seats that remain unfilled will be converted to the General Merit Quota.

If sufficient candidates are not available for filling the seats reserved for Economically Weaker Sections (EWS) in General Category, the seats that remain unfilled will be converted to the General Merit Quota.

Aided Colleges:

If sufficient candidates are not available for filling the seats reserved for SC/ST candidates in Aided Colleges, the same will be notified in the media three times (on three different dates) and a separate allotment for SC/ST candidates will be made by the University. However, even after this, if SC/ST seats are still vacant, same will be filled as per the following norms.

1. The vacant SC/ST seats if any, in Aided Forward/Backward Colleges will be filled by admitting candidates belonging to Socially and Educationally Backward Communities (SEBC), strictly in accordance with the rules and guidelines for admission. The seats that still remain un-filled will go to the General Merit Quota.
2. The vacant SC/ST seats if any, in Backward Aided colleges with Minority Status will be filled by admitting candidates from the Community Quota Ranklist of the colleges, strictly in accordance with the rules and guidelines for admission.

4. CLAIMS FOR MANDATORY RESERVATION AND CERTIFICATES TO BE PRODUCED

- (i) Claims for Mandatory Reservation must be made by a candidate at the time of submission of online application. Candidates should mention their claim in the relevant columns in the Personal and Academic Data Sheet. They should also satisfy the eligibility conditions as per the Prospectus (Clause 5) at the time of online registration.
- (ii) Candidates should produce all original documents to prove their claims made in the online application form at the time of admission before the Principal. **Claims that are not mentioned at the time of submission of online application will not be entertained even if supporting evidences are produced later on.** The claims for mandatory reservation once made cannot be altered by the candidate under any circumstances.

Claim for reservation under “Socially and Educationally Backward Classes” (SEBC):

Reservation of seats to the Socially and Educationally Backward Classes will be in accordance with the provisions contained in G.O. (P) 208/66/Edn. Dated 02.05.1966, as amended from time to time.

Candidates belonging to Ezhava, Muslim, Other Backward Hindu, Latin Catholic/SIUC and Other Backward Christian communities, claiming reservation under SEBC quota should invariably produce “Non Creamy Layer Certificate” obtained from the Village Officer concerned. Candidates belonging to Non Creamy Layer only are eligible for claiming reservation to SEBC category. Annual Income is not a criteria for reservation under SEBC category. List of communities under SEBC category are given in **Annexure V**. *The validity of Non Creamy Layer certificate is one year.*

Claim for reservation under Scheduled Castes (SC) / Scheduled Tribes (ST) quota:

Candidates belonging to SC/ST communities allotted against merit seats or against the seats reserved for them are exempted from payment of fee at the time of admission. Candidates claiming reservation under Scheduled Castes/Scheduled Tribes quota should obtain the Caste/Community Certificate from the Village

Officer/Tahsildar. (See Annexure II and Annexure III for list of SC and ST). **The validity of caste certificate of SC/ST is three years.** ST candidates can produce SSLC certificate as proof.

Warning: Those who produce false SC/ST Certificate for claiming reservation under SC/ST quota shall be liable for penalties as per rules.

The seats unavailed by the SC candidates will go to ST candidates and vice versa

Claim of OEC candidates against the un-availed seats of SC/ST candidates.

Other Eligible Community (OEC) candidates are eligible for the un-availed seats, if any, under SC/ST quota. The communities given in Annexure IV only are eligible for such un-availed seats, if any, under SC/ST quota (G.O.(Ms)No.14/2017/BCDD dated 02.08.2017). OEC candidates who possess “Non Creamy Layer Certificate” obtained from the Village Officer concerned alone are eligible for such seats.

Note: *Converted Christians do not come under the SC/ST category. They belong to OEC category. (Ref. Annexure IV)*

Claim for fee concession to OEC candidates. Candidates belonging to Other Eligible Communities are exempted from payment of fee at the time of admission to FYUG Programme under Government/Community quota seats, irrespective of annual family income as per G.O (MS) No. 36/07/SCSTDD, dated: 03.07.2007. **(Communities listed in Annexure IV).**

OEC candidates will be granted the fee concession based on the Non-Creamy Layer Certificate. But those OEC candidates who do not come under Non-Creamy Layer category should produce the Community Certificate obtained from the village officer at the time of admission for availing the fee concession.

Claim for fee concession to the candidates who get OEC educational assistance.

As per the G.O.(Ms) 10/2014/BCDD dated 23.05.2014, 30 communities from state OBC list are selected for OEC educational assistance subjected to a maximum of Rs. 8 Lakh annual income. (G.O (MS) No. 03/2018/BCDD) dated 09.04.2018 **(Communities listed in Annexure V.A).** They should provide Community and Income Certificates from the Village Officer at the time of admission. **The validity of income certificate of OEC community is one year.**

Claim for reservation under Economically Weaker Sections (EWS) in General Category in Govt./Self Financing Colleges and UIT’s

Candidates belonging to the communities listed in Annexure V.B who are economically backward are eligible for EWS reservation. Such candidates must produce either of the certificates from the village officer namely “The applicant belonging to Anthyodaya Anna Yojana (AAY) and Priority House Hold (PHH) category” or “The income and assets certificate for Economically Weaker Sections (EWSs) in General Category”. **(Communities listed in Annexure V.B)** (Format of certificates is given in Annexure XI and XII).

Ration Card or BPL Certificate is NOT a valid document to avail EWS reservation. Candidates who enjoy Communal Reservation such as SEBC, SC/ST are NOT eligible for EWS reservation.

Notwithstanding anything contained in the Statutes, the selection of students in Government colleges shall be governed by the rules prescribed by the Government from time to time with the concurrence of the University in respect of such admissions.

5. RULES FOR ADMISSION – NATIVITY, ELIGIBILITY, RANKING AND WEIGHTAGE

5.1 Nativity

Candidate should be an Indian citizen. Candidates seeking admission to FYUG Programme will be categorized as **Keralite and Non-Keralite**

- (i) **Keralite:** A candidate of Kerala origin will be categorized as a Keralite. **Children of All India Service Officers allotted to Kerala Cadre are deemed to be Keralites** as per G.O. (Rt) No.822/08/H.Edn. dated 9-5-2008. But they will not be eligible for communal/special reservation.
- (ii) **Non-Keralite:** A candidate who does not come under Keralite category will be categorized as Non-Keralite. Non-Keralite candidates will be eligible for admission only after all the applicants of Keralite origin are ranked and allotted. Such candidates are not eligible for Communal reservations or any kind of fee concession.

In order to prove that a candidate is an Indian citizen of Kerala origin for the limited purpose of eligibility for admission, he/she has to produce any one of the following certificates at the time of admission.

- (a) In the case of candidates who have undergone schooling in Kerala, a course certificate from the head of the

educational institution last attended in Kerala, certifying that the candidate has undergone his/her studies in Kerala for not less than 3 (three) years within a continuous period of 12(twelve) years.

OR

- (b) A certificate from the Village Officer/ Tahsildar to show that he/she or his/her mother/father was born in Kerala.

OR

- (c) Certificate from the Village Officer/Tahsildar to the effect that the candidate has been a resident of Kerala State for a period of five years within a continuous period of twelve years

OR

- (d) The true copy of relevant page of Secondary School Leaving Certificate showing the candidate's Place of Birth is in Kerala.

OR

- (e) The true copy of the relevant page of the Secondary School Leaving Certificate showing Place of Birth in Kerala of either of the parents of the candidate with corroborative certificate to establish the relationship between the parent and the candidate.

OR

- (f) The true copy of the relevant page of the Passport of the candidate, issued by the Government of India, showing Place of Birth in Kerala or of either of the parents of the candidate showing Place of Birth in Kerala with corroborative certificate to establish the relationship between the parent and the candidate.

5.3 Assessment of Merit

Except when otherwise provided, the merit of a candidate will be assessed on the basis of the marks obtained by him/her in the qualifying examinations for admission to the particular course, subject to such criteria as may be prescribed by the University.

Standardization of marks for admission to FYUG Programme– Guidelines issued (2010-2011 onwards).

A. Higher Secondary/ VHSE (NSQF) (2022 onwards)

I. In the case of Higher Secondary Examination from 2010 onwards and VHSE (NSQF) from 2022 onwards, the index marks are to be calculated as follows.

Total marks secured for Higher Secondary + Marks secured in the concerned subject.

For e.g. If the student has secured 800 marks out of the total 1200 marks and if he has secured 150 out of 200 in mathematics, his index marks will be $800 + 150 = 950$.

In the case of admission to B.A English, double the percentage of marks obtained for English are added to the total mark. If the student in the above example has secured 120 marks out of 200 in English, his index mark will be $800 + 120 = 920$.

II. In the case of Higher Secondary Examination prior to 2010, normalize the total marks obtained out of 600 to 1200 and add twice the marks obtained in the subject concerned for calculation of index mark.

In the case of admission to B.A English, double the percentage of marks obtained for English are added the same to the total marks, normalized to 1200.

B. Vocational Higher Secondary (Till 2021)

In the case of Vocational Higher Secondary examination, exclude the marks for vocational subjects and foundation course and normalize the marks as follows:

1) In the case of VHSE (prior to 2010) the marks for English (out of 100) to be normalized to 200. Marks for Optional (3 subjects) (Total 3 x 100=300) to be normalized to 400.

For e.g. if a VHSE student received the following marks,

English = 41, Optional 1 = 47, Optional 2 = 58, Optional 3 = 65 Total = 211.

i. For English, $(41/100) \times 200 = 82$

ii. For Optional, $(170/300) \times 400 = 226.66$

Total out of 600 = $82 + 226.66 = 308.66$

Total out of 1200 = $308.66 \times 2 = 617.32$

In the case of admission to B.A English, double the percentage of marks in English and add to total i.e., $617.32 + 82.00 = 699.32$. Index Marks is 699.32.

2) In the case of VHSE students from 2010 onwards, English Total = 200, Optional 1 = 200, Optional 2 = 200, Optional 3 = 200. Therefore, Grand total = 800.

Normalize as follows:

i. Normalize the marks obtained for English to 400

Eg: If a student received 150 marks out of 200 then, $150/200 \times 400 = 300$

ii. Normalize the marks obtained for optional subjects to 800

Eg: If a student received a total of 500 marks out of 600 in the 3 optionals, then, $500/600 \times 800 = 666.66$ Therefore, total out of 1200 = 966.66

In the case of admission to FYUG Programme in English, since the marks are awarded out of 200, add these marks to the normalized optional marks. Index marks = $966.66 + 150 = 1116.66$

C. Other Boards such as CBSE and ICSE

In the case of other Boards such as CBSE and ICSE, normalize the total marks to 1200 and then add **TWICE THE PERCENTAGE** of marks obtained in the subject concerned.

For Example: If a student has secured 400 out of the total of 500 marks in the CBSE stream and if he has say, secured 80 marks out of 100 in mathematics, his index marks will be $400/500 \times 1200$ plus 160 (i.e., 80×2) marks of mathematics. That is $960 + 160 = 1120$. In the case of admission to FYUG Programme in English, double the percentage of marks obtained for English and add to the normalized total marks. If the student in example above secured 70 out of 100 marks in English, then his index mark will be $960 + 140 = 1100$

For subjects which are not being offered at the qualifying Examination level, the marks of related subject or subjects, a knowledge of which is essential for the study of the subject proposed to be chosen for the First Degree Programme, shall be added to the total marks for the purpose of ranking.

5.4. Weightage / Deduction of Marks

In assessing merit, marks will be awarded for extracurricular activities like NCC, NSS Student Police Cadet (SPC) and Scout & Guides of the students and also to Ex-servicemen / widows or children of Jawans and Ex-servicemen.

These marks will be added to the marks obtained for the qualifying examination for preparing the rank list. The weightage of bonus marks shall be added to the marks scored by the candidate either to make him/her eligible for admission to a Programme or for ranking purposes to those who are otherwise eligible for admission. In the case of candidates who get the eligibility by this bonus marks, their ranking mark will be the sum of scored marks and the bonus marks.

- **5.4.1 Weightage of marks for NCC / NSS / SPC/ Scout & Guides certificate holders**

A weightage of 15 marks will be given to NCC / NSS / SPC (Student Police Cadet)/ Scout & Guides certificate holders for the purpose of ranking. **The candidates who have attended NSS / NCC / SPC/ Scout & Guides during the academic year of the qualifying examinations ie, plus two only will be eligible for the bonus mark.**

Note:

- a) In respect of candidates who want to avail bonus marks for NCC, the marks will be awarded on the basis of NCC Weightage Certificates signed by the Director and issued by the Directorate of NCC to the candidates who have secured at least 75% of attendance after having participated in its activities during the course of study immediately preceding the course for which admission is sought.
- b) For awarding bonus marks to NSS participants, the basis will be NSS certificates signed by the Competent Authority.
- c) For awarding bonus mark to SPC, the basis will be the certificates signed by the Competent Authority
- d) For awarding bonus mark to Scout and Guides, the certificate signed by the Competent Authority shall be submitted.(Only Rajyapuraskar & Nanmamudra Certificates are accepted).
- e) **The benefit of bonus marks for purposes of admission can be earned by the candidates only under any one category (either NSS or NCC or SPC or Scout and Guides).**

- **5.4.2 Weightage of marks for Ex-servicemen/ widows or children of Jawans and Ex-servicemen**

A weightage of 15 marks will be given to the Ex-servicemen / widows or children of Jawans and Ex-servicemen for admission. (U.O. No. Ac.B.3/Misc./73 dated 30-10-1974). (Academic Council dated 28-08-1974). (Applicable to Army/Navy/Airforce only. Not applicable to paramilitary forces/CRPF/GREF/Coast Guard etc.)

To avail the weightage of bonus mark under the category “Ex-servicemen / widows or children of Jawans and Ex-servicemen”, the candidates should invariably produce **an attested copy of certificate issued not earlier than six months from the last date of submission of application, from the military authorities or State/Zilla Sainik Welfare Officer to the effect that he/she is the son/daughter/widow of a Jawan / Ex-service man or an Ex-service man himself/herself.**

- **Deduction / Loosing of marks for subsequent appearances**

Candidates will lose 10 marks from the total ranking marks for each additional appearance he/she has taken for completing the qualifying examination.

- **Resolving of tie**

In the case of tie of index marks, the following will be considered

- * Marks of the subject opted
- * Marks of English
- * Date of Birth (older be placed higher in ranking)
- * Name of the Candidate (Alphabetical order)

The Candidates who have passed qualifying exam under ISC or any other boards which have more than three electives will have to submit more than one application with different electives, in case they wish to seek admission for all the electives they have studied.

For example, if a candidate who has studied Mathematics, Physics, Chemistry and Biology as electives and wish to apply for B.Sc. Mathematics should compulsorily enter the marks of Mathematics plus the marks of any other two electives (say Physics and Chemistry) as per their choice of that stream. If this candidate wishes to apply for B.Sc. Botany or B.Sc. Zoology, he/she will have to submit separate applications with separate registration fee.

5.5 Joining for a UG course after Cancellation of a course

Candidates undergoing various courses in the University or who have registered/appeared for any of the degree examinations of the University in regular mode are permitted to cancel registration/examination for the purpose of joining for the same course in the University in regular mode, as a one-time provision, only under any of the exigent circumstances as detailed below.

- i. Issues in the college where he/she has pursued the course (like ragging, issues with college authorities/ other

students etc)

- ii. Distance from home town.
- iii. Non availability of college hostel.
- iv. Death or serious illness of parents/supporting guardian.
- v. Illness of the candidate causing disability/serious illness of the candidate.
- vi. Difficulty to commute due to accident, surgery etc.
- vii. Difficulty to continue studies due to financial crises in the family.

Candidates who have cancelled a course from this University or any other Universities and joining for any FYUG programme under the University of Kerala shall submit cancellation memo of previous course at the time of admission to the college.

- **Pursuing additional UG degree**

A student who has already successfully completed a FYUG Programme and is desirous of and academically capable of pursuing another FYUG Programme may also be admitted with the prior approval of the University according to conditions regarding course requirements specified by the University.

6. HOW TO APPLY

- (a) Any candidate who wishes to join FYUG Programme under the University of Kerala should compulsorily register online @ <http://admissions.keralauniversity.ac.in>.
- (b) The site is optimized with the latest versions of Mozilla Firefox, Google Chrome etc.
- (c) The candidates are advised to enable “JavaScript” before proceeding with the Registration
- (d) Read the instructions carefully before proceeding with the registration.
- (e) Do not press “back” button during the process of registration.

STEPS FOR THE ONLINE REGISTRATION PROCESS

➤ Step I: Generating Application Number and Password

The first step of UG online registration process is generating application number and password. For this, the candidates have to click on "**Click here for Registration**" button available in the UG admission portal of the website www.admissions.keralauniversity.ac.in. After that, the candidate has to provide the details like Exam Board, Register Number, Year of Passing, Name, Date of Birth, Gender and Email id. After entering the required details, the candidate will be provided with a unique **application number** and **password**. Date of birth is the default password in the format **dd/mm/yyyy**. (This application number and password must be used for completing the registration process.)

❖ Login

The candidate should login with the Application number and Password which they have generated through the previous step.

❖ Instructions for Online Registration

Candidates are advised to read the instructions carefully before registration. After reading the instructions click the "**Proceed**" button. **Do not press “BACK” button during registration.**

➤ Step II : Personal Details

Candidate should enter the personal details here. Fields marked with * are mandatory.

19. **Special Weightage** (Candidate can claim if he/she has any weightage for NCC, NSS, SPC or Ex- servicemen / widows or children of Jawans and Ex-servicemen. Documents should be available with candidate to support the claim. (See prospectus clause 5.4.1 and 5.4.2))
20. **Differently Abled** (It mentions to claim reservation of seats for candidates with benchmark disabilities. If the candidate chooses YES, he/she has to submit certificates to support the claim (Clause 3.2).)
21. **Reservation for Nominees** : (See prospectus clause 3.1)
22. **Have you represented any sports competitions?** : (The candidate can select 'YES' if he/she wish to apply under **Sports Quota**. He/she has to select the level of achievement and also mention the sports item.)

After completing the profile registration, the candidate can continue registration by clicking button "**Save and continue**". It directs to the page, Academic Profile Registration.

➤ **Step III: Academic Profile Registration.**

Enter the following details of the qualifying examination of the candidate.

1. **Type of Examination** (Regular, Part-time or Open school.)
2. **Board of Study** (Select HSE-Kerala, VHSE-Kerala, ISC, CBSE, THSE or OTHERS. If the candidate has studied in Other Boards (Open School, +2 from other state boards etc.) he/she has to obtain Eligibility Certificate from the University of Kerala and shall submit the same to the college if he/she gets admission.)
3. **Stream** (Stream of study like Science/Humanities/Commerce)
4. **Year of Passing** (Select the year of passing of qualifying examination)
5. **Number of Appearances** (The number of chances taken to complete the qualifying examination)
6. **Examination Register Number** (The Register number of qualifying examination. (ie, +2 level))
7. **Pre-knowledge of Arabic** (If the candidate has pre-knowledge of Arabic in secondary or higher secondary level, click yes. This is applicable for only those who wish to take admission for BA Arabic course.)
8. **Mark Details** (Choose appropriate Mark System. If the candidate has studied under Grade

system, It is his/her responsibility to convert his/her grades into marks by following the directions from his/her board of study and produce the valid documents at the time of admission.)

THE CANDIDATE HAS TO FILL THIS PAGE FROM TOP TO BOTTOM, ONE BY ONE.

The candidate studied in any boards other than Kerala HSE or VHSE and those passed Kerala HSE or VHSE in any year other than 2024, have to fill the correct details of marks obtained and maximum marks as in the certificate.

After filling the above details click "Save and continue" button for submitting these details

➤ **Step IV : Add and Change Options**

- Selection of choices is to be done with utmost care. On each selection of programme/college options, the same may be added to the list of options by invoking "Add Option" button. A student can add up to a maximum of 20 options for Registration.
- The preference numbers along with the selected options shows the priority of options. So candidate must be very careful in prioritizing their options.

The steps involved in changing the preference of options are summarized below.

- a) Click on the option to be changed
- b) Suppose the candidate wants to change preference to a higher one (eg:-option with preference no.3 need to be changed to the one with preference no 2), click the row with the option to be moved, click Up arrow (↑) once so that it will be changed accordingly. By clicking the down arrow (↓), the candidate can bring the preference to a lower one. If option 5 is to be brought to 2, the up arrow has to be clicked thrice. Existing option can be deleted by clicking the (✖) button link.
- c) **DO NOT FORGET** to click the button 'Save & Refresh Options' to finalize changed priority options.

➤ **Step V : Registration Fee Payment**

The Registration Fee will be as follows:

- For General/SEBC candidates: Rs. 900/-
- For SC/ST candidates: Rs. 500/-

Candidates should pay the registration fee by using the online payment facility after clicking on “Pay Online” button.

Candidates shall not remit the fee in any other form like Demand Draft, Cheque, Chalan etc

After completing the payment, the candidate should continue the registration process.

Note : The online payment receipt should be kept safely as the same is to be submitted to the college at the time of admission.

The Registration fee once remitted will not be refunded under any circumstances.

➤ **Step VI : Upload photo and Signature**

Photo [with 150px X 200px (WIDTH X HEIGHT), 40kb, .jpg format only]. Photo must be clear and with light background. Signature [with 150px X 60px (WIDTH X HEIGHT), 40kb, .jpg format only]. For uploading photo and signature, select the image file in the computer using "Browse" button. After uploading the photo and signature, click "Continue" button for further registration.

➤ **Step VII : Verify the Application**

After adding all the options, click “Preview and Verify Completed Application” button for further

registration. A thorough verification be performed before taking printout. Provision for editing is permitted in some specific fields in each section.

➤ **Step VIII : Print out of completed application form**

Click the 'Print Completed Application' button to take the print out of the completed application form. The Registration process is completed only after taking the print out of the completed application form.

Candidates are instructed to submit their application online within the time schedule specified, through admission portal.

❖ **Mode of Registration for Sports Quota**

The candidates who select YES to the question “Have you represented any sports competitions?” in the first step of online registration process will be provided with an intermediate step **after Step 5** (After Adding Options), for uploading sports achievement certificates. They have to select the level of achievement and upload scanned copy of corresponding certificate in the respective field. There will be no limit in uploading the number of certificates. Once the certificates are uploaded, registration process can be continued.

❖ **Conditions for updating the information and options already given online.**

A candidate can edit some of the information given at the time of registration, by entering the Home Page using his/her application number and password.

- i) An authorized applicant will be directed to his/her home page with a group of navigation links (My Home, Index Mark, Allotment, Edit Profile, Completed Profile, Password and Logout). In the link “My Home” the applicant can view the status of the application. Click the “Preview & Print Completed Application” button to view /print the application.
- ii) Using the link “Completed Profile” the candidate can edit some of the personal details, already given at the time of online registration.
- iii) Using the link “Academic Profile” the candidate can change the details of Qualifying Examination except Board, Register Number, Year of passing of Qualifying Examination and the name of the subjects passed.
- iv) Using the link “My Options” is provided for the candidate to add/delete/change the preference of the options.
- v) After effecting all the changes, the latest printout be taken from “Completed Profile” page.

If the candidate still needed correction in the profile , but cannot edit on their own in the profile, they can use the link “FORUM” given in the student profile.

The candidates are advised to use the “Logout” link at the time of exit from his/her Home Page

Do not send hard copy of online registration to the University. The hard copy of the online application and the originals of all certificates should be kept by the candidate for submitting the same at the time of admission in the respective college. The candidate who fails to produce the printout of the application form and original certificates at the time of admission shall not be considered for admission.

7. ONLINE CENTRALIZED ALLOTMENT PROCESS

• 7.1 Trial Allotment

A trial allotment will be published after the closure of registration in the profile of the candidate, to give an idea about the chances of getting admission to a Programme at a particular college, based on the options registered by the candidate and editing is permitted before First Allotment. **The trial allotment does not guarantee admission to the candidate.**

• 7.2 First Allotment

After the trial allotment and the period earmarked for revising options, the first allotment will be published in the website on the date to be notified. Candidates can check the details of allotment in the “Allotment” link provided in

their profile. **The candidates who get allotment have to remit the University fee as per the procedure mentioned in clause 7.3 and ensure their seat, and those who fail to remit the fee in time will not be considered for further allotments.** The candidates will have to follow the notification of the University with regard to the date of admission in the college concerned..

7.3 Fee to be paid to the University on allotment.

On securing allotment, the candidates have to remit the University admission fee mentioned in clause 8 through online mode (e-payment) only in the “Allotment” page of valid applicant’s homepage in the website (<http://admissions.keralauniversity.ac.in>). A printout of the payment receipt should be taken and the same should be kept safely and be submitted to the Principal at the time of admission. The candidate without the payment receipt will not be allowed to join the college. The candidates should keep a copy of the payment receipt. It will be required for further allotments, if any.

Candidates SHALL NOT remit the fee in any other form like Demand Draft, Cheque, Chalan etc.

- **7.4 Downloading Allotment memo.**

After the first allotment, candidates can Login to their homepage using their application number and password for downloading the memo (Allotment memo can be downloaded only by those candidates who have remitted the University admission fee as per clause 7.3). Using the link “Allotment” the applicant can view his/her allotment details and can download the allotment memo which has to be produced before the Principal at the time of admission. The allotment memo will show the personal details, the college, the Programme to which the candidate is allotted and the date of reporting to the college for taking admission.

- **7.5 Cancellation/Activation of options after the first allotment:**

Candidates who remit the fee after first allotment within the prescribed time will have the facility to cancel/activate their higher options before the second allotment during a specified period which will be notified.

After the first allotment, the options below the “allotted one” of the candidate will automatically be removed from the option list of the candidate. For example, if a candidate had registered 20 options in all, and if he/she is allotted to his/her 10th option, all options from 11 to 20 will be automatically removed from the option list. Options from 1 to 9 will remain valid and will be considered for future allotments. He/she may cancel/activate any options among the remaining options as per his/her choice. But the candidate will not be permitted to register any fresh options to the existing ones.

Existing options registered by the candidate, available in the Home Page, can be cancelled one by one by clicking the “CANCEL” button shown against each option or all higher options can be cancelled by clicking “CANCEL ALL HIGHER OPTIONS” button, if the candidate desires so. Option once cancelled can be activated again using “ACTIVATE” button, within a specified time period.

If a candidate is satisfied with an allotment and does not want to be considered again for further allotment(s), he/she must cancel all the remaining higher options. A candidate retaining all or any of his/her higher options after an allotment, is bound to accept the new allotment, if any, failing which, he/she will lose the existing allotment as well as the new allotment; moreover he/she will not be considered for any further allotments.

The facility for cancellation/activation of options will be available during the notified period only.

It is advised to keep a copy of allotment memo with the candidate for future purpose if any. Allotment memo issued to a candidate for a particular allotment will not be issued again at a later stage under any circumstances.

- **7.6 Post Allotment Activities**

1. **Reporting at the College:** Allotted candidates have to report before the Principal/Head of the College/Institution concerned on the dates notified for admission, with the documents mentioned in clause

9.

- 2. Fee to be remitted in colleges at the time of admission:** Apart from the fee already remitted to the University as per Clause 8, the fee applicable to the programme / institution has to be remitted to the college at the time of admission.

- The fee due to the colleges shall not be levied in advance from candidates belonging to SC/ST, OEC and also from candidates who get OEC educational assistance.
- All candidates (including SC/ST/OEC) will have to pay the “Caution Deposit” during admission as per rules.
- PTA fund shall not be compulsorily levied from SC/ST candidates.

- 3. Verification of Documents:** The Principal/Head of the Institution shall be personally responsible for verification and satisfaction of the correctness of the records produced by the candidate at the time of admission in the college/Institution. The candidates should fulfill the eligibility criteria at the time of online registration and all relevant documents mentioned under clause 9 shall be submitted at the respective colleges during the time of admission

- 4. Failure to report for Admission:** Candidates who do not take admission on the prescribed date and time in the allotted college will lose their admission and they will not be considered for further allotments.

- 5. Cancellation of Higher Options after joining a college:** Candidates who joined the college on the date specified, can either cancel their remaining options fully or partially or change the priority of their remaining options before the date specified as per the procedure. If not interested in any further allotments, all the higher options may be cancelled before the date specified, failing which, the options that remain valid will be considered for further allotments, if any

- **Supplementary / Further allotments.**

Candidates who get allotment in supplementary/further allotments shall follow the instructions given in clause 7.3, 7.4, and 7.6. Details regarding the procedures of supplementary allotments will be notified later

The candidates need to remit the University admission fee only once during this process of allotment which would confirm their seat in any of the colleges as per their preference and eligibility.

- **Temporary Admission**

Candidates can opt for temporary admission in colleges during the first allotment. They will be given an extended time for remitting the fee applicable to the programme / institution till the next allotment. Such candidates,

- Have to submit the original certificates and the receipt of University admission fee.
- They can choose whether to take temporary or permanent admission and the same need to be assured by the Principal. The admission, whether permanent / temporary will be given in the admit memo issued to the candidates.
- This provision is not applicable from 3rd allotment onwards and it is compulsory to take permanent admission in the college by remitting the requisite fee.
- If the candidate is satisfied with any of the allotments, he/she can take permanent admission by remitting the requisite fee.

8. FEE TO BE REMITTED TO THE UNIVERSITY FOR ADMISSION

Any candidate who get allotment / admission shall compulsorily remit the below mentioned University admission fee for taking admission in the college.

Note: Candidates who passed the qualifying examination from Other Boards (Boards other than Kerala HSE, Kerala VHSE, AISSCE/CBSE, ISC) are exempted to pay the fee for Eligibility. Such students should obtain Eligibility certificate from the University of Kerala before registration and shall submit the same to the college if he/she gets admission

Remittance of University admission fee for candidates who get admission other than through allotments (management quota, community quota, sports quota, Lakshadweep quota, admission through special order etc.) shall also be done in online mode. The candidates shall approach the Principal of the college concerned for enabling the payment link in candidate profile.

9. DOCUMENTS TO BE SUBMITTED AT THE TIME OF ADMISSION

All candidates who take admission in a college shall submit the following documents before the Principal/Head of the College/Institution concerned. **No additional time will be granted to the candidates for submitting the documents at the time of admission.**

- c) The original fee receipt / transaction slip towards University Admission Fee.
- d) Allotment Memo (Latest) in case of candidates who get admission through centralized allotment/spot allotment **OR** Letter duly signed by the Registrar in case of candidates who get admission through special order
- e) Original mark list/certificate of the qualifying examination.
- f) Certificate to prove date of birth.
- g) TC from the Institution last attended.
- h) Course & Conduct Certificate.
- i) Migration Certificate from the Board/University last studied.
- j) Course Cancellation memo from the University last attended (if applicable) (See clause 5.5)
- k) Certificates from the village officer namely “The applicant belonging to Anthyodaya Anna Yojana (AAY) and Priority House Hold (PHH) category” or “The income or assets certificate for Economically Weaker Sections (EWSs) in General Category” for candidates under EWS category.
- l) Caste/Community Certificate for candidates under Scheduled Castes/ Scheduled Tribes quota.
- m) Non Creamy Layer Certificate in the case of SEBC candidates.
- n) Non Creamy Layer Certificate in the case of OEC candidates claiming vacant SC/ST seats.
- o) Non Creamy Layer Certificate/Community Certificate in the case of OEC candidates claiming fee concession.
- p) Community Certificate and Income Certificate in the case of candidates eligible for OEC educational assistance (Annexure V.A)
- q) Original certificates to prove the claim for grace marks/weightage if any.
- r) Eligibility Certificate from the University of Kerala in case of candidates who have passed qualifying examination other than HSE/ VHSE conducted by Government of Kerala or the examination conducted by CBSE (AISSCE) and ISC.
- s) Transgender identity card issued by the State Government if applicable.
- t) Undertaking from the students as per the provisions of anti-ragging verdict by the Hon’ble Supreme Court of India. (Annexure VII)
- u) Any other relevant certificate for any claim made in the application.

❖ SPECIAL INSTRUCTIONS

1. **Failure to report for Admission:** Candidates who do not take admission on the prescribed date will lose their allotment. They will not be considered for any further regular allotments under any circumstance.
2. Candidates have the freedom to change their password; however, they should take note of the password and application number carefully for future login.
3. Applications of candidates who do not register their personal and academic data online and who do not give their options online within the time schedule will not be considered for allotment.
4. No opportunity will be given to incorporate any details after the last date of submission of application. Late or defective application will not be considered under any circumstances.
5. Any kind of false information will lead to cancellation of admission.
6. Any Boards, where the grades are awarded instead of marks, the candidates should enter the corresponding marks, while entering the academic data.
7. Rounding of marks / percentage to the nearest whole number will not be permitted.
8. The University will not entertain any request for change of the dates of Online Centralized Allotment.
9. Any other item not specifically covered in this prospectus will be decided by the University and that decision shall be final.
10. **Preventive measure against ragging: If an applicant for admission is found to have indulged in ragging in the past or if it is noticed later that he/she had indulged in ragging, either he/she will not be admitted or shall be expelled from the educational institution.**

The fee structure of self-financing arts and science programmes in colleges affiliated to universities in Kerala was revised vide G.O.s read as 1 to 3 above.

2. Associations of various Self Financing Arts and Science College Managements have requested Government to revise the fee structure of self-financing arts and science programmes in colleges. Also, the Hon'ble High Court of Kerala, vide judgments read as 5 to 7 above, directed Government to consider the requests and pass appropriate orders in the matter.

3. In the circumstances, as per the G.O. read as 8th paper above, Government constituted a committee to look into the demands of the

managements of self-financing Arts and Science Colleges for revision of fee structure of self-financing arts & science programmes in affiliated colleges in the State and to report to Government regarding the matter. The Committee recommended a hike of 12% in the existing fee structure of self-financing arts & science programmes in affiliated colleges from the academic year 2024-25 onwards.

4. Government have examined the matter in detail and are pleased to revise fee structure of self-financing arts and science programmes in colleges affiliated to universities in Kerala by enhancing 12% to the existing fee structure from the Academic Year 2024-25 onwards.

5. Further, upon introduction of the Four Year Degree Programme in the State from the Academic year 2024-25, the fee structure of programmes will need to be further revised as per course /credit system. In the circumstances, Government shall consider to constitute a Committee, as and when the necessity arises, comprising of the Registrars of the Kerala, Mahatma Gandhi, Calicut and Kannur Universities as members to suggest a feasible fee structure for the courses and thereupon, a further restructuring of fee of the courses shall be made.

As per Government Order read above, Government have issued orders for enhancement of all fees including Tuition fees, Hostel fees, Exam fees, University fees etc., of all the students including Professional course students studying in Government, Aided and Government controlled self Financing institutions and Grant-in-Aid Agencies under the control of Technical Education Department by 5% each year and thereafter every year.

2. The Director, IHRD as per the letter read above has requested Government to revise the fee structure for the courses in Engineering Colleges, College of Applied Sciences, Polytechnic Colleges and Technical Higher Secondary Schools based on the above Government order.

3. Government have examined the matter in detail and are pleased to revise the fee structure for the courses in Engineering Colleges, College of Applied Sciences, Polytechnic Colleges and Technical Higher Secondary Schools under IHRD from the academic year 2022-2023 onwards as follows:-
