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#### **Preface**

The government of Kerala has initiated reforms in the higher education sector by adopting the recommendations of Professor Syam B Menon commission. One of the recommendations of the commission was the introduction of Four-Year under Graduate Programme (FYUGP) in the state. The University of Kerala has already prepared a curriculum framework and regulations for FYUGP. On the basis of this curriculum and regulations, the Board of Studies in Performing and Visual arts has designed a syllabus for the implementations of the newly proposed FYUGP in Dance (Keralanatanam) under University of Kerala

The Arts are a universal language that transcends cultural boundaries. Art is an essential element in empowering people's hearts. It unites people as reflections of humanity instead of dividing them across linguistic, political, social and cultural boundaries. Art education provides the students with a creative outlet through which they can improve their problem solving skills in everyday life. Art studies make students aware of how to deal with issues they face in society and how to explore issues in unconventional ways.

Keralanatanam is an innovative dance form that originated from Kathakali. It is an art form developed by Indian dancer Dr.Guru Gopinath with a unique structure to present ideas through Angika, Vachika and Satvika abhinayas, aside from the Aharya abhinaya in Kathakali. By realizing the importance of the art form of Keralanatanam, one can explore their individuality, develop critical thinking skills and develop the confidence needed to succeed in all walks of life. The objectives of including Keralanatanam as a subject in the under graduate course are to create interest in this art form and to acquire the ability to understand the differences and importance of acting in this art form various art forms. It develops creativity and critical thinking. Enhances self - presentation skills and communication skills. Encourages the development of cultural awareness, understanding and empathy. Enables students to gain awareness of different cultures and traditions. Opening up new perspectives to the students. Social issues ,Myths, Spirituality, Conflicting emotions, Complex human relationships, Different cultures and ways of life are exposed. It helps students appreciate the artistry of others and understand the world from multiple perspectives. Able to understand the literature and the essence of the language in the cultural world around us and thereby reflect the culture, history, values and interactions of the Indian people with civilization. It is certain that through this study, wisdom and will power will increase and the door will be opened to self – organizing dance items, personal growth and creating socially responsible creations.
