### **Updates in the PG Prospectus 2019**

The following changes have been made in the prospectus for PG Admission 2019.

1. Clause 8.3 (Page No: 35) – Fee to be paid to the University.

Fee detail of SC/ST/OEC category students is modified as "SC/ST/OEC students should remit a token amount of Rs.100/- to assure their allotment/ admission. Premium for Student Care Fund of Rs.200/- (onetime payment for two years) shall also be remitted along with the token amount, at the time of admission".
