### **Eligibility:**

Candidate seeking admission for MTTM shall be required to possess either a Bachelor's Degree from the University of Kerala or a Degree recognized as equivalent there to with a minimum of 55 percent in aggregate in Part III subjects for Science and 50 percent in the aggregate of part III for non-science subjects or a Degree in Engineering with not less than 55 percent marks in aggregate. Relaxation in minimum marks for admission and reservation of seats for SC/ST/OBC and other categories will be allowed as per existing University norms.

### **PREPARATION OF RANKLIST:**

The rank list for MTTM Degree Programmes will be prepared on the basis of marks/CGPA/CCPA obtained in the qualifying examination in Part III Subjects/Core and Complimentary Courses, (including weightage/deduction wherever applicable), unless otherwise mentioned. The rank list will be prepared based on the total marks/ Percentage of CGPA (CBCS Prior to 2013 admissions)/ CCPA(CBCS 2013 admissions onwards) (converted by the formula provided by respective University) obtained by the candidate out of 1000.

The internal marks awarded at the B.Com/BBA level will not be considered while calculating index marks. NOTE: In case of the candidates who have passed the Vocational/Restructured the marks scored in the University Examination (2nd, 4 th and 6 th semesters) alone will be considered for ranking purpose.

**Christian Nadar**

At present, Christian Nadar category is not eligible for EWS reservation.

**FEE TO BE REMITTED TO THE UNIVERSITY FOR ADMISSION**

**SC/ST/OEC candidates should remit the Premium for Student Care Fund of Rs.200/- (onetime payment for two years), at the time of admission.**

**NOTE**

**The remaining fee (Rs. 830/-) in Govt./Aided Colleges/UITs is to be claimed by the College from the SC/ST Department and remitted to the University. The rates are same as that of General candidates.**

**In the case of self financing colleges, since they are not eligible for claiming the fee from SC/ST department, the same shall be collected from the students and remitted to KUF immediately on closure of admission itself.**
